

What We Need

- Confirmatory screening
- Who defines
 - EA much like the Justice Potter
 Stewart said in Jacobellis v. Ohio
 - $\circ~$ "I know it when I see it"
- Can we move beyond the "Stewart" definition (or should it)?
- Can we know (and detect) markers/risks with "causal certainty" (or something approximate to that)?
- What interventions prevent EA? Can they be applied in an era of populism and individual "freedom" ?



To Our Partners and Advocates

- Great work but more to do
 - Societal sense of unacceptable behavior
 - Legal and Legislative support (but is it a State or Federal issue)
 - Improved professional knowledge, awareness, & willingness to act
 - Effective advocacy groups and leading the charge
